Psalm 150:4 says we are to "Praise Him with tambourine and dancing". Worshipping God through Anointed Dance is an extremely delightful thing in the eyes of God and people. Dances brings out a deep and visual expression – Bridal love for our Heavenly Bridegroom, appreciation to God, joy and rejoicing, adoration, intercession, praises and worship. It is an expression beyond languages that can be understood by all nationality and God can use this movement to touch and bless the church and it's congregation. Dance carries the anointing to liberate the spiritual atmosphere of worship as well as releases joy, blessings and healing to the body, soul, mind and spirit.

Psalm 20:5 says: "We will rejoice in your salvation, and in the name of our God We will set up our banners! May the LORD fulfill all your petitions."

Lifting up the banner never fails to enhance any Praise and Worship session. It bestow honor to our King and releases powerful declarations of who God is. It is high and exuberant expressions in worship. God is highly exalted in our praises and declarations. Banners helps ushers in God's Presence in a visual way. The Name or symbol on the banner can draw people to it's meaning which will bring faith and worship to another level.

Dancing with Banners – what a perfect combination to behold God's beauty and to seek Him in His Temple (Psalm 27:4). It can bring forth a greater awareness of the move and anointing of the Holy Spirit, angelic activity and presence and greater release of God's blessings and revelations to the church. Sometimes, to Throneroom level where wings banner are most appropriately used to signal to all worshippers where the Holy Spirit is leading to. It can reveal and reflect the heart of worship, vision and goal of the church and the worshippers by the banners displayed.

God desires the Bride of Christ to be ready for the coming of the Heavenly Bridegroom – JESUS. And one of the way to be ready is to be rejoicing with singing and dancing. He is coming and we are proclaiming it through our dances and banners.
